The end of Key Stage 2 National Curriculum tests (SATs) are undertaken during the week beginning Monday 14th May.

Following the successful use of revision guides in the core subjects last year, there will be a meeting for parents on **Wednesday 17th January at 7.00pm** on the use of **Revision Guides** and information regarding the KS2 national tests.

Year 6 pupils will be briefed on usage but we strongly believe the meeting will still be valuable to help parents support their children.

Attendance Awards

Congratulations to the **150** pupils who, last term achieved **100% attendance** certificates. Children who received a **Bronze Award** certificate and continue to achieve 100% will qualify for a Silver Award at the end of this term.

Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is additional money for schools to support raising the attainment for their most vulnerable pupils including those who have been adopted from care. In order for school to receive funding, children need to be recorded as eligible on the school census. **We are not necessarily aware that a child has been adopted and therefore encourage parents and guardians to present this information to us. As is the case for all sensitive information this will be treated in the strictest confidence.**

The school can also apply for a service pupil premium for children of Regular Armed Forces personnel. Please notify the school if you are an employee of any of the Forces.

Every Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 pupil is entitled to a school meal as part of the government's universal school meal initiative. However, the school may be eligible for additional funding if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit with no element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income of below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit.

In order for the school to access this funding you will need to complete a short application form for Pupil Premium. This can be done online at <http://www3.northamptonshire.gov.uk/councilservices/children-families-education/schools-and-education/Pages/free-school-meals.aspx> and select the dropdown for your child's year group.

We urge all parents who receive benefits, which in turn entitles their child to Free School Meals, to inform the school so that the central budget allocation can be received.
