County Athletics Success

At the weekend (14th and 15th May) Amelie H, Hope S, Will B and Fraser L competed for Rugby & Northampton AC in the Northamptonshire County Athletics Championships.

Will and Fraser competed in the U11 boys, Will won the long jump with 3m 47cm becoming County Champion with Fraser finishing a close 2nd with 3m 35cm to take silver. Will followed this up with 3rd in 600m and 2nd in 150m, with Fraser finishing 5th. In the final race, 75m, Will came away with another silver, making 4 medals in total and Fraser finished 6th.

Hope competed in the U13 girls 1200m and came 2nd.

Amelie competed against older girls in U13 girls. In the 200m she managed to get to the finals and crossed the line in 6th. She finished 5th in the 800m and 4th in the 1500m. In the long jump she jumped 3m 30cm to take 4th place.
