#### Primary Word Friday 23rd June 2023

#### <u>Science Olympics - Pitsford School.</u>

Yesterday, Wednesday 21st June, we went to Pitsford School on a minibus and were greeted by a member of staff. We were then taken to the science room where we would be doing most of our activities and met the seven other schools and staff. They explained how we were to keep safe. This included wearing lab coats and safety glasses.

Our first activity was to identify some unknown chemicals. We did this by putting some named chemicals on tapers which we then put into a high Bunsen burner flame to see

which colours appeared in the flames. The second task was amazing! It was to make three different bubble mixtures to see which would give the biggest bubble. We used combinations of washing up liquid, water and glycerin.

After break we had a science-based orienteering activity. It was fun. Next it was back to the lab to test how much vitamin C each of 5 juices had. Lemon juice had the highest and surprisingly, orange concentrated juice had the lowest. This was followed by lunch and a science quiz.

Next was our favourite - elephant toothpaste! Made from potassium iodide, hydrogen peroxide, food colouring and washing up liquid. Finally, we had to make a rocket from a 2 litre plastic bottle, card and water.

Although we didn't win the longest distance our rocket did a very impressive back-flip! We really enjoyed the day. It was a great experience. - By Annabelle, Jerry, Maia and Lucas, Year 5
