#### Flu Vaccine Monday 2nd October 2023

The Flu Vaccination is taking place on the above date for all children. An online registration form has been sent home this week via ParentMail.

It is essential if you would like your child to have the flu vaccine that you submit the form online by **9am on Wednesday 27th September.** After this time the online form will close and no applications can be made after this date. If you do not submit a form your child will not be offered the vaccination in school.

#### The Importance of Primary School Attendance

We would like to clarify the school's and indeed the national expectations in terms of attendance at primary school. Often we can see 90% attendance and feel that 90% sounds pretty good, however it is not.

The gradings for school attendance are:

97% - 100% - Excellent to Good

95% – 97% - Acceptable

90% - 95% - Poor

Below 90% - A child with persistent absence and a cause for concern.

If a child has 90% attendance at the end of the year they will have missed **19 days** of learning or **over 100 hours** of lesson time. It is so important for your child's education and future that they are in school.

We fully understand if a child is ill and feels unwell they need to be off school and we will always try to support them with this, however over the last year an increasing number of parents, at Brixworth and nationally are taking children out of school for holidays. Headteachers are not allowed to authorise absence for holidays unless there are really exceptional circumstances.

The Local Authority can and do fine you for taking your child on holiday during term time without exceptional reason. An initial fixed penalty notice of £60 is issued to each parent for each child. So a two parent family with two children would be fined £240.

These fines would be issued:

- When a pupil has a minimum of 10 school sessions recorded as unauthorised in a 6 school week period; (a school day is two sessions - morning and afternoon) or
- When a pupil has a series of unauthorised absences leading to irregular attendance

We also recognise the increase in cost of taking holidays during school holiday periods, however taking them out of school in term time will impact their education and we ask that you give full this consideration before taking them out of school.

#### **Pupil Premium and Free School Meals**

#### Foundation Stage, Year 1 or Year 2

Every child in Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 is entitled to a school meal as part of the government's universal infant free school meals scheme. However, the school may be eligible for additional funding if you receive any of the following benefits:

- 1.Income Support
- 2.Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- 3.Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit
- 4. National Asylum Seekers Support
- 5. Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- 6.Employment and Support Allowance
- 7. Universal Credit (Income Related)

In order for the school to access this funding you will need to complete a short application form. This can be done online at <a href="Apply for free school meals - WNC - Introduction - Online form (achieveservice.com)">achieveservice.com</a>) and select "Pupil Premium." You will be advised immediately if your claim is successful. Please let school know the reference number for your successful claim.

#### Year 3 to 6

If you are in receipt of any of the above benefits you can claim for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium. Please use the link above and select "My child is in year 3 or above" and then "Apply for Free School Meals." Once your claim has been validated please contact the school with the reference number for your successful claim and we will support you in ordering your children's meals.

#### **Adopted Children**

Pupil Premium is additional money for schools to support raising the attainment for their most vulnerable pupils including those who have been adopted from care. In order for school to receive their funding, children need to be recorded as eligible on the school census. We are not necessarily aware that a child has been adopted and therefore encourage parents and guardians to present this information to us. As is the case for all sensitive information this will be treated in the strictest of confidence.

#### **The School's Dress Code**

As a school we always encourage the wearing of school uniform.

Uniform embroidered with the Brixworth logo can be ordered on line at <a href="Home-Brigade Clothing, LTD">However</a>, we are very conscious as a school that uniform costs are high and as such, we do not insist that the children wear clothing with the school logo. Most supermarkets sell the coloured uniform at much lower prices. As long as their uniform is in school colours this will be fine.

#### The uniform is:

**Girls** - Navy blue school sweatshirt or cardigan, white or blue polo shirt, navy blue or grey skirt, pinafore or trousers.

Boys - Navy blue school sweatshirt, white or blue polo shirt, grey or black trousers.

Boys and girls must wear dark shoes.

#### For PE lessons pupils need:

Plain white or blue t-shirt, plain black or blue shorts or jogging bottoms, plimsolls and a pair of trainers for outdoor lessons. The kit is in keeping with the school's colours. As above, the PE kit can also be ordered through Brigade.

Children must not wear any jewellery, including earrings for PE. Hair must also be tied back.

We would also ask that children do not wear hoodies to school, even in Brixworth colours.
