Year 5 & 6 Sportshall Athletics


Last week we went to an athletics competition for school. We all did four activities, two track events and two field events. Our team came first and we all tried so so hard. Well done to Brixworth.

Key Stage 2 (Years 3 - 6) Carol Concert

Please enter the school via the main school pupil entrance on Froxhill Cresent (not the office) and drop your child to their classroom between 5.40-5.45pm. Children <u>MUST</u> arrive on time.

Children have been invited to wear a Christmas jumper but they will also need to wrap up warm.

Parents will then progress to the school playground. Refreshments will be available in exchange for a small donation.

Children will be seated in a designated area on the playground in their class groups. We estimate the concert should last for around an hour. Once the carol concert has finished your child will return with their teacher to their classroom. Please make your way to your child's classroom to collect them from there.

If your child is in Mrs Varrier's or Miss Duckworth's class please collect them from the staff car park. You can access this by using the door at the top of the ramp near the pod.

All pupils MUST be collected from their classroom as no pupil will be allowed to walk home alone.
