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

Week 2: 2nd - 8th March


On the second day of creation, God made the sky and water.

On Thursday 27th February a visitor who was a Sikh came to talk to us about Sikhism. Sikhism is a fifth largest religion in the whole world. Gurmukhi is one language which they learn. They have leaders which Sikhs call Gurus. Guru means they take away your darkness and give you your light. There are five K's - the Kirpan is a knife which is the symbol to say stop and help others. The Kesh is a hat they wear to cover their hair because they make a promise to not cut their hair.
