Primary Word is the school's weekly newsletter. Each Friday this is issued via ParentMail (a copy is also available on the school website). On the front page, the clubs, events and activities for the next week are listed, usually with times and the person responsible. In the event of a club having to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, for example a staff absence, the pupils in that club will be supervised in school until the end of the club's duration.

If a club is not on Primary Word then it will not be taking place.

Parents should check the newsletter to confirm whether or not a club is running.

School Rules

The School's Dress Code

The wearing of school uniform is not compulsory but is encouraged. **The majority of parents choose, and most pupils wear, the uniform.** Uniform is ordered on line at www.brigade.uk.com. The school office holds samples of uniform to aid you with sizes.

The uniform is:

Girls - School sweatshirt or cardigan, white or blue polo shirt, navy blue skirt, pinafore or trousers.

Boys - School sweatshirt, white or blue polo shirt, grey or black trousers.

Boys and girls must wear dark shoes.

For PE lessons pupils need:

T-shirt, shorts and plimsolls and a pair of trainers for outdoor lessons. The kit is in keeping with the school's colours and uniform, and as above, can be ordered from Brigade.

Children should bring their PE clothing to school in a cloth / soft plastic bag, which should be taken home at the end of term to be washed. Children may not wear any jewellery, including earrings for PE. Hair must be tied back for PE and Sport.

Please ensure that all clothing is clearly named.

Sports wear, including tracksuits and football shirts, are not acceptable as school-wear.

Jewellery (other than stud earrings) is not permitted. Pupils should not wear trainers all day and must have a change of footwear for outdoor P.E.

Grants for young people in Brixworth and Scaldwell

Are you a young person, under 25 years of age, that wants a cash grant for educational purposes?

The Foundation of Thomas Roe provides small cash grants for young people who live in the parishes of Brixworth or Scaldwell.

Grants have previously been provided to support young people with: purchase of school uniform; books and course materials; musical instruments; computer equipment; and travel expenses linked to education, including school trips.

Application forms are available from Brixworth Library and from the Information Services, located in the foyer of Brixworth Library. They can also be downloaded from Brixworth and Scaldwell Parish Council web sites. Completed application forms must be returned to the Clerk by midnight on **18 September 2019** for consideration at the charity's next meeting. This meeting is scheduled for 2 October, where grant applications will be considered.

Attendance

If your child is unable to attend school please ensure you notify the school office by 9.00 on the morning of absence.

We are obliged to obtain a reason for all absences from school and therefore will use any information we have to acquire the reason your child is unable to attend school.

Any unexplained absences will need to be recorded as unauthorised.

If you arrive at school after 9.00am children must sign in at the school office before going to their classrooms.



School Parking

At the start of the new school year parents are reminded to be mindful when dropping off or picking up their children and not to fall into the habit of parking illegally or in a thoughtless or dangerous manner.

The area outside school entrances must be kept clear to allow an unrestricted view for approaching drivers and riders or children wanting to cross the road. Road markings are there for a reason and drivers **must not** wait, park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers on school entrance markings.


I have also been asked to advise you that you do not have permission to park in the numbered and visitor parking spaces in Highfield Close as these are for residents use only.


