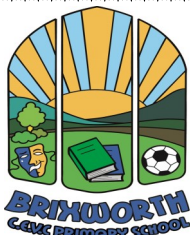

#### Facts About Attendance

Did you know....

- Pupils with no absence are 1.3 times more likely to achieve the expected standard or above than pupils that missed 10-15 per cent of all sessions.
- Being 15 minutes late each day is the same as missing two weeks of school over the year.
- For every day of school missed by a pupil, it will reduce their attendance by 0.5%.
- Ten full days of school have been missed by a pupil if their attendance is 95%.
- Twenty full days of school have been missed by a pupil if their attendance is 90%.
- By the time a pupil is persistently absent (85% attendance) they have missed 6 weeks or half a term of schooling.

## Harvest Service Thursday 17th October 2019

**Year 1** children will be going to **All Saints Church** in Brixworth on the morning of **Thursday 17th October**. They will be taking part in a special service to celebrate **Harvest**. The children will be performing songs and poems which they have been working hard to learn at school and at home.

**Parents and members of the wider community are welcome to attend the service which will begin at 10.30 am.** The classes will need some parental support in walking the children to and from the church. Please inform your child's class teacher if you are able to assist with this.

We plan to distribute harvest gifts to senior citizens in the village. **Kindly ensure that your donations are in a form suitable for use by an individual Senior Citizen. Made up boxes/baskets are most welcome as are individual items that we can then make up into boxes at school.** *(Please avoid large, perishable items, and check use by dates of foods donated.)*

*Donations should be taken to your child's classroom between Monday 14th and Thursday 17th October.*

*Class teachers and children will take ownership of their classes contributions towards harvest.*

**Foundation Stage** pupils will deliver produce to community centres in the village. *If any parents are available to help walk with the children, please speak to the FS teachers.*

**Year 6 children**, supervised by members of staff, will then deliver the donations to the individuals concerned on **Friday 18th October**.
