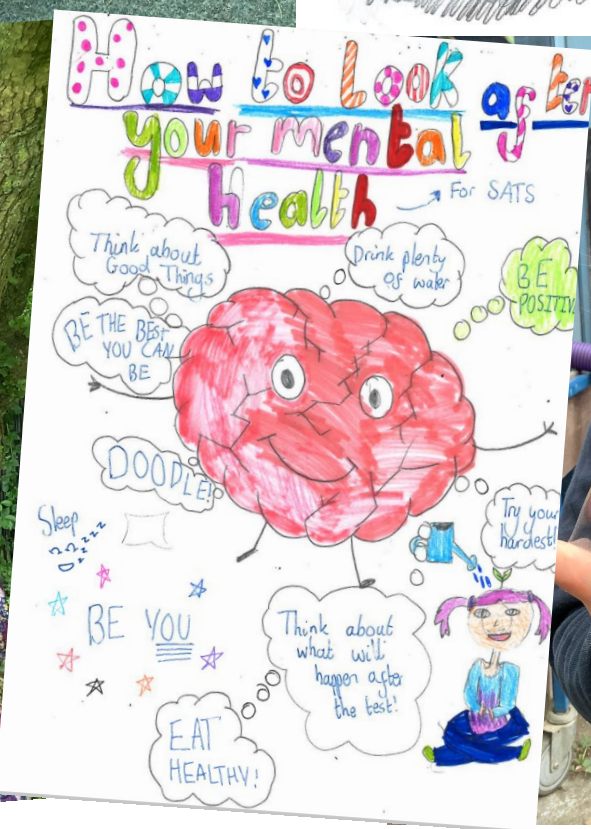
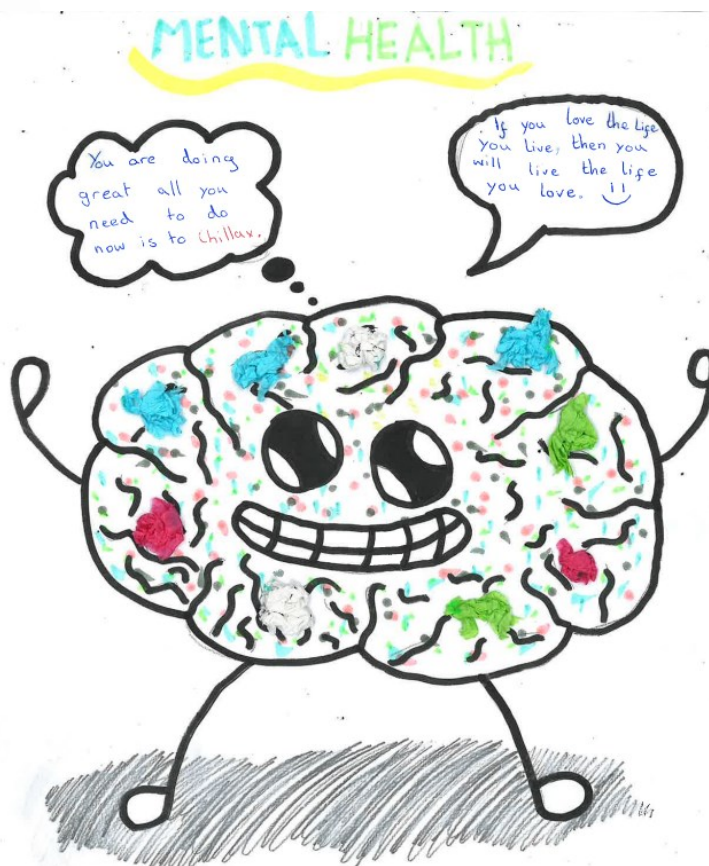
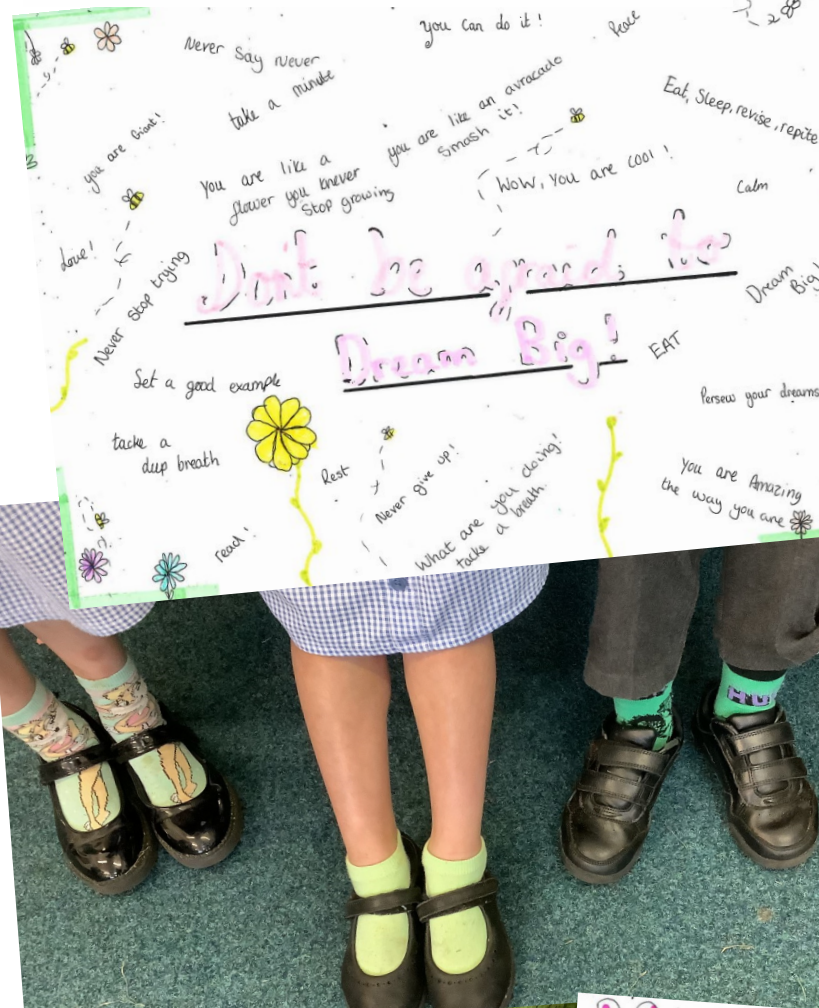




# Mental Health Awareness Week

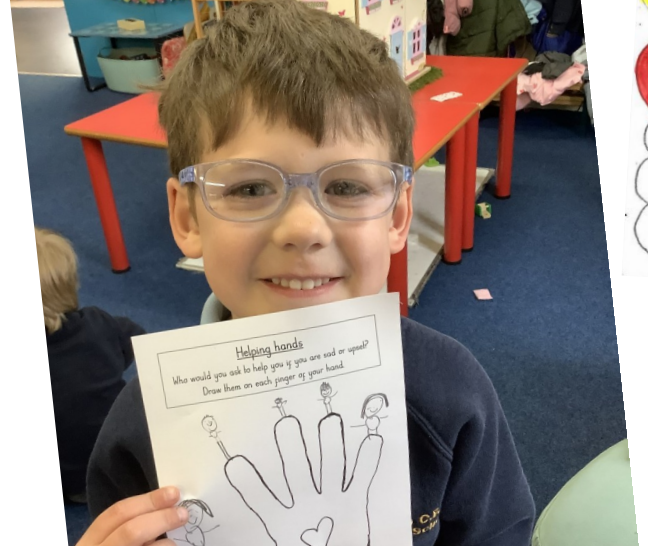
