Flu Vaccine Friday 15th November

The Flu Vaccine is taking place on the above date for all children and forms were sent home with children this week.

It is essential if you would like your child to have the flu vaccine that their forms are returned by Wednesday 23rd October.

If your child has experienced any of the below symptoms please let the school office know on the day of their vaccine.

- 1) If your child is unwell or has been off school in the 48 hours prior to the vaccination.
- 2) If your child has a temperature the day before or on the day of the vaccination.
- 3) If your child has been wheezy in the 48 hours prior to the vaccination session or they have had their asthma medication increased.
- 4) If your child has taken or been commenced on oral steroids in the 2 weeks prior to the vaccination session.
- 5) If your child has been given the vaccination elsewhere.

The school aims to achieve 100% attendance at parents evenings and it is hoped that every parent will take the opportunity to meet with their child's teacher.


