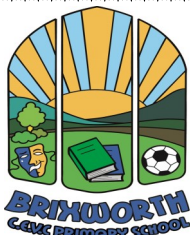

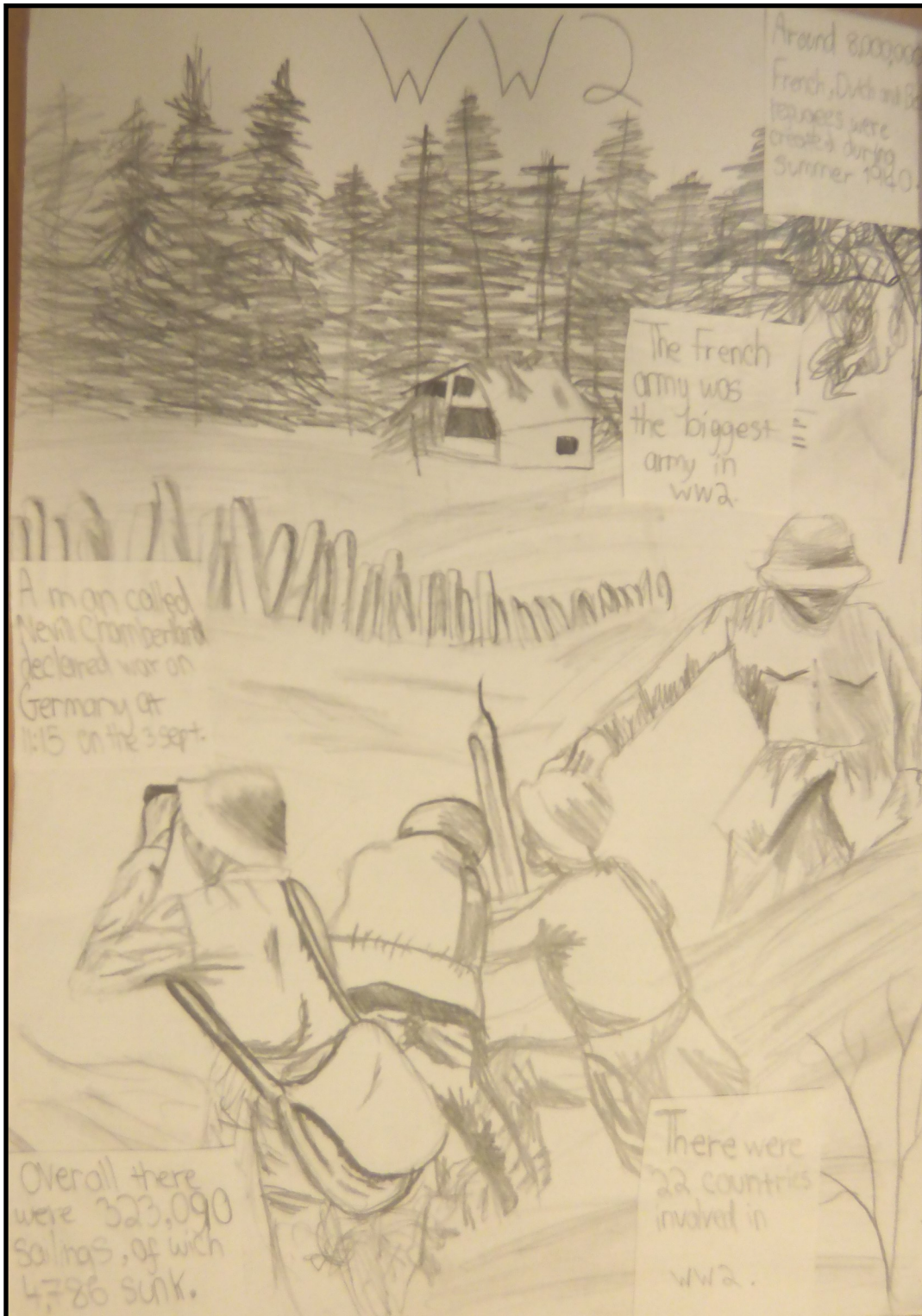
Trip Costs

- an adult helper


for the icing
