

Christmas Performances

The entrance for the audience is through the doors at the POD entrance. Pupils must be collected after the evening performance as no pupil will be allowed to walk home alone. Pupils will be ready for collection at 7.05pm.

Recording of the performances will be allowed for family use only.

Please do not use flash photography during the performance.
