

PARENTS EVENING

Parents Evening meetings will take place in the Key Stage Two classrooms. Below is a plan of the upper school and the classroom where each teacher will be based. The Key Stage Two teachers will remain in their class apart from Mrs Casson, and be joined by a Foundation Stage or Key Stage One teacher. Access to and from the school will be by the office door only. Please note there will be two teachers in each classroom.

Your child’s books will be with the teacher who will give them to you should you wish to browse through them after your meeting.

If you need to bring your children with you then you will need to bring a quiet activity which will entertain them whilst you have your meeting.

Thursday 5th March


World Book Day is next week. As part of our celebration of books, we would like to encourage the children to dress up as a character from a book. It can be any character.
