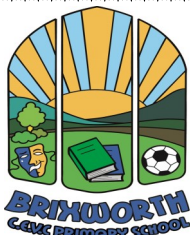

#### **On the third day of creation, God made land, sea and plants.**

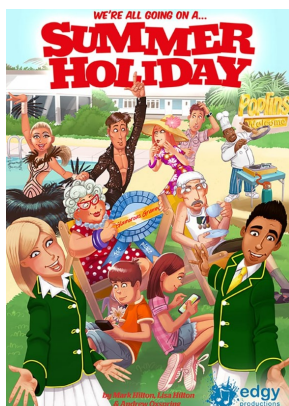

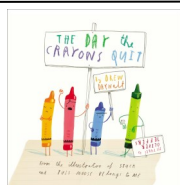
# Our New Library



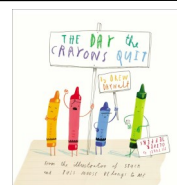

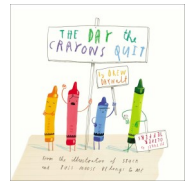

Mrs Stiles class were given a panel of the picture each to colour in creatively and then they put the panels back together to create our safari mural.

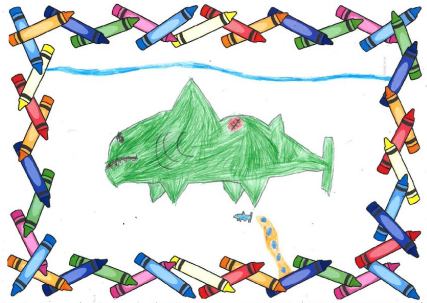
